

Delinquent Taxes

The County Clerk's Office is responsible for collecting delinquent property tax bills.

The current year tax is collected in the Sheriff's Office. For more information about
the current tax bills or for an amount paid on a bill that is not delinquent, please contact
the Garrard County Sheriff @ 859 792-3591.

Our office does not accept partial payments on delinquent tax bills. If you are unable
to make a full payment, you may contact the County Attorney's Office @ 859-792-2331
for payment arrangements.

On April 15th, the Sheriff's Office turned over all unpaid tax bills to the County Clerk.
Each year the Clerk is responsible for conducting a tax sale on the delinquent tax
bills. During the tax sale, the delinquent tax bills are eligible to be purchased by a
third party. The tax sale may occur no earlier than 90 days and not later than 135
days after the clerk has received the bills. The actual date of the sale will be determined
and posted on this website as well as the Department of Revenue's website
@ www.revenue.ky.gov. The delinquent bills must be advertised no more than 45
days and no less than 30 days before the tax sale.

The 2012 tax bills will be sold on July 31, 2013.
